RE



This term in RE we are looking at sources—in our local community; Eucharist Unity and Lent and Easter where we are looking at Death and New Life.

Topic

To be or not be, that is the question.

Science

Y6 will be looking at Light where they will learn to recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines. Use the idea that light travels to explain that objects seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye; explain how we see things as light travels from light sources and explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them. We will also be looking at Living things and their habitats. Where the pupils will be taught to describe how living things are classified into groups according to their similarities and differences. As well as giving reasons for classifying plants and animals based on their characteristics.

The children will continue with their game designs and implement them on the computer. They will design, write and debug programs to solve problems. As well as using sequences, selection and repetition in a program and detect and correct errors.

As well as building on their flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance through dance, gymnastics and athletics.
