Subject	Content
English	<b>Wolves in the Walls</b> – multi-clause sentences and punctuation <b>Monsterology Handbook</b> – Conjunctions, prepositions, adverbials and commas <b>Cloud Tea Monkeys</b> – Looking at how mood and atmosphere are created through dialogue and speech <b>Visual Literacy</b> - looking at different books and writing narratives <b>Love that Book</b> – The Promise by Nicola Davis
Maths	<b>Multiplication and Division</b> – reinforcing multiplication of a single digit by numbers up to 4 digits, multiplication of 2 digit numbers using the formal method and dividing using formal and mental methods.  <b>Fractions</b> - Adding and Subtraction fractions with the same denominator, adding and subtracting fractions with denominators which are multiples of each other and multiplying fractions by integers.  <b>Decimals and Percentages</b> – understanding decimals with up to 3 decimal places, understanding thousandths, rounding decimals, ordering and comparing decimals, understanding percentages, and finding equivalents of percentages, decimals and fractions.

### Home Learning

#### **KS2 Year 5 and 6**
