### Attendance and registration reminder

A reminder that school doors are open **8.45am** for Nursery and **8:50am** for the rest of the school. This means that the classroom doors will be closed from 9:00am for registration. If your child arrives after this time, they will need to come through the school office to be signed in and it will be recorded on their attendance record as late (L sign on their registration certificate). If they arrive after 9.20am, this will still be late but will be unauthorised (U sign on their registration certificate).

If your child is going to be absent, please call the school office and leave a message on the absence line. If we have not been informed about why your child is absent, it will be recorded as an unauthorised absence. Please be aware, if your child builds up a number of unauthorised absences, you may be liable to a fine from Central Bedfordshire.

While we do appreciate there are times when being late is unavoidable, this should be the exception rather than the rule. Our School Attendance Office and our Educational Welfare Officer monitor your child's attendance, number of late arrivals and unauthorised absences. You are encouraged to bring your child to school **on time** every day as this is a key way to support them in their education. Thank you for your support of us in this way.

Please remember we have a breakfast club available so you can drop your child off from 7:50am if this is easier for you. The cost is £3.50 per session. Please talk to the office to register for breakfast club.
